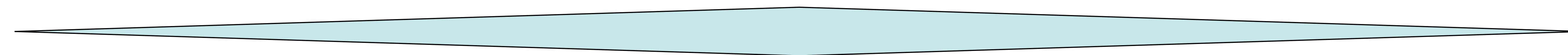


Fusion evaporation reactions as a tool for light nuclei gamma spectroscopy
